## Healthy Home Assessments

In our Healthy Home Assessments, our trained technicians visit the property to complete a full external and internal audit. Once complete, you'll receive a full report documenting everything required to meet the regulations and a completed 13A Compliance Statement.

If any work is required to meet compliance, simply arrange this with tradies of your choice, then load proof of the completed works (photos of remedy or invoices) into the customer portal to update the assessment and generate an updated compliance statement at no additional cost.

### What sets our service apart



Heating calculations are conducted within our own custom software which means a permanent digital copy of calculations is available. This allows fast and simple recalculation for layout changes and insulation changes.



We don't charge for report updates. Instead, our Customer Portal allows clients to upload evidence of completed work to update reports instantly and regenerate Compliance Statements.



Integration with Property Management systems like Palace means Healthy Homes data is automatically updated in your system as soon as the report is complete. Clients have reported this saving hours of admin time.

## Maintaining Healthy Homes Compliance

**As the Healthy Homes deadline has now passed, there is a greater focus on what landlords and property management companies should be doing to ensure properties remain compliant at all times.**

Compliance with the regulations is now more closely monitored than ever before with the establishment of The Tenancy Compliance and Investigation Team.

With each new or renewed tenancy landlords are required to provide an updated Healthy Homes Compliance Statement. At the bottom of the statement is a declaration that is signed by the landlord or Property Manager stating that the information contained within the Statement is "true and correct at the time of signing". Failure to provide a true and correct statement is a breach of the Residential Tenancies Act and is considered an unlawful act which can result in a fine of up to \$900 through either the Tenancy Tribunal or Tenancy Compliance and Investigation Department.

MBIE state that during regular inspections and at the end of the tenancy landlords need to:

- Check that the heater and ventilation system are in good working order. This could include checking its fixtures and fittings and replacing any filters.
- Check the insulation is still in good condition (for example, there are no gaps) and continues to meet the standard.
- Check the gutters, downpipes, drains are still doing the job.
- If the property has an enclosed subfloor, check the ground moisture barrier is still in good condition.
- Ask the tenants if they've noticed any new draughts in the rental.
- Check any seals, sealant or blockages that need to be maintained to ensure they prevent any draughts coming in or out of the property.

### Healthy Homes Check Up - \$129+GST\*

As Tenancy Tribunal case law develops, the industry is developing a best practice recommendation for reassessments. Current recommendations suggest evidence to support a compliance statement (for example a Healthy Home Assessment) will be questioned if it is more than 2-3 years old. The length of time you're comfortable using an existing assessment as the sole evidence of compliance will depend on your own appetite for risk. Whatever your appetite, there will come a point when the initial report conducted will need updating.

Our reassessment services help ensure you meet your ongoing responsibility of monitoring and managing the continued compliance for your property and is designed to be used as evidence should you be required to provide it.

# Smoke Alarm Compliance

Keeping track of working smoke alarms has been a legal requirement for property managers and landlords since 2016. The regulation requires qualifying smoke alarms to be installed within 3 metres of each bedroom door, or in every room where a person sleeps and in each level or storey of a multi-storey or multi-level home.

## Unlimited Smoke Alarm Service Plan - \$99+GST per annum (2 year commitment)

To ensure ongoing compliance our annual smoke alarm service includes unlimited callouts, **unlimited smoke alarm installs** required for compliance, replacement of damaged or expired alarms\* along with a full report and certificate.

Note: This service plan is for a minimum of 2 years and covers battery operated alarms only.

## Methamphetamine Testing

Healthy Homes New Zealand samplers are NZQA qualified

### Field composite

Multiple samples are taken within a property and then combined into a single test tube on-site and sent to the laboratory for analysis. The results are reported as an accumulative total.

#### Advantages:

- One sample is taken in every 'high use' area in accordance with NZS8510:2017.
- As only minimal test tubes are used, the cost of analysis is more affordable.

#### Disadvantages:

- As the samples are combined into a test tube, if contamination is found, we are unable to isolate which room/s are contaminated.

### Laboratory composite

Multiple samples are taken within a property, and all samples are sent to the laboratory for analysis. The laboratory will take an extraction from each test tube and combine them into a single analysis. The result shows the maximum level of methamphetamine that could be present on a single swab.

#### Advantages:

- One sample taken in all 'high use' areas in accordance with NZS8510:2017.
- As the samples are all stored individually, if contamination is found they can be analysed individually to ascertain which sampling locations are contaminated (reanalysis is an additional cost of \$79+GST per test tube).

#### Disadvantages:

- As samples are taken and kept individually, the sample collection takes longer, and stricter cross-contamination practices must be enforced - which increases the cost.
